Peter organized The Rainbow Nation Band in 2007 with several of Hawaii's best musicians including Zanuck Lindsey (guitar), Shawn Ishimoto (lap guitar), Dean Taba (bass guitar), Adj Larioza (drums/percussion) and Dan Del Negro (keyboards).

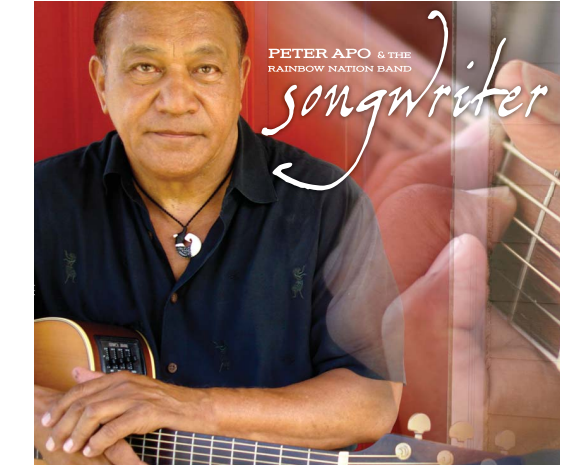
Peter and his band released their new CD "Songwriter" in December of 2009. In 2008, Peter was nominated for a Na Hoku Hanohano award for his previous CD titled "Aina".

Peter Apo is an accomplished songwriter, singer, and musician. His recorded music is rooted in the folk-rock genre while his live performances roam the spectrum of folk, blues, standards, and Hawaiian.

Peter spent many years as a folk musician based in Los Angeles with the band The Travelers Three. They toured the nation's colleges and coffee houses for several years and recorded 3 albums for the Elektra label and one for Capitol Records.

After the Travelers Three disbanded, Peter returned to Hawai'i and in the latter 80's began songwriting as a serious avocation and also embarked on recording several solo albums.

In 2006-07 Peter launched an all-folk CD titled "My Back Pages" which commemorates the great folk songwriters and performers like Bob Dylan, Tim Hardin, Jesse Colin-Young, Gordon Lightfoot,



The Songwriter CD includes nine original compositions written by Peter Apo, two songs written by good friends and a song written by Peter's eldest son, Kalani Apo.
